Sworn Complaint No. SC-3100246 alleges that the respondent: 1) did not properly disclose political contributions and political expenditures on campaign finance reports as required by section 254.031 of the Election Code and section 20.61 of the Ethics Commission Rules; 2) did not include on campaign finance reports the principal occupation or job title and the full name of the employer for individuals who contributed \$500 or more to him during a reporting period, as required by section 254.0612 of the Election Code; 3) did not properly disclose reimbursements on campaign finance reports, as required by section 254.031 of the Election Code and section 20.62 of the Ethics Commission Rules; and 4) did not timely file a January 2009 semiannual report, as required by section 254.063 of the Election Code.

Sworn Complaint No. SC-31110224 alleges that the respondent failed to keep his political contributions in one or more accounts that were separate from any other account that he maintained, as required by section 253.040 of the Election Code.
