MINUTES

This meeting was recorded. These minutes are a summary record of the Commission's actions at the meeting. For a detailed record of discussions and statements made by persons speaking at the meeting, please consult the audio recordings on file at the Commission's office.

Agenda Item 1: Call to order; roll call.

The meeting was called to order by Chair Ramsay. David A. Reisman, Executive Director, called the roll. All Commissioners were present, except for Commissioner Harrison, who was delayed.

Agenda Item 2: Communication to the Commission from the public.

Tom Swearingen spoke before the Commission regarding electronic filing issues, timely filing, and late-filing fees for local filers. He stated that he was concerned about whether there was any follow-up to see that reports are being filed locally. Mr. Swearingen also stated that he had come to see what the Commission is doing and for the opportunity to speak before the Commission.

Agenda Item 3: Comments by the Commissioners.

None.

Agenda Item 4: Comments by the executive director.

David A. Reisman, Executive Director, made the following comments:

- 1. Mr. Reisman stated that a former employee, Lisa Noblin, had passed away. He stated that Lisa had worked in Disclosure Filings for over 20 years. Mr. Reisman expressed sympathy to Lisa's parents and family.
- 2. Mr. Reisman discussed e-mail notices. He stated that in 2009, the legislature changed the rules to allow the Commission to send filing notifications by e-mail. He stated that over half the filers were on the e-mail notification list. Mr. Reisman then stated that the Commission has the ability to send notices, surveys, educational materials, filer tips, and other information to filers by e-mail. He further stated that this has improved filing compliance tremendously.

Agenda Item 5: Approve minutes of the June 6, 2012, Executive Session and the June 6, 2012, Commission meeting.

Motion by Commissioner Untermeyer to adopt the minutes of the June 6, 2012, Executive Session and the June 6, 2012, Commission meeting, second by Commissioner Mendoza. **Motion passed by a vote of seven ayes.**

Agenda Item 6: Presentation and discussion on the duties and responsibilities of the Public Integrity Unit of the Travis County District Attorney's Office. Presentation by Gregg Cox, Director of the Public Integrity Unit.

Greg Cox, Director, Public Integrity Unit, Assistant District Attorney, Travis County District Attorney's Office spoke before the Commission. He gave an overview of the unit, what they do, how the unit is organized, and their responsibilities. Mr. Cox stated that the unit is a division of the district attorney's office, is funded by the state, and is organized into four sections – General State Government Investigation, Motor Vehicle Tax Fraud, Insurance Fraud, and Workers Compensation Fraud. He then stated that the general state government unit handles financial crimes where the state is the victim of fraud or a financial offense that occurred in Travis County. Mr. Cox further stated that the area that receives more publicity involves public corruption in which some cases involve the Code of Criminal Procedure and the Texas Constitution. He also stated that the unit gets referrals from several state agencies and from the public. Mr. Cox then explained the process followed in a formal investigation.

Agenda Item 7: Presentation, discussion, and possible action on the FY 2012-13 Legislative Appropriations Request of the Texas Ethics Commission. Presentation by David A. Reisman, Executive Director.

David A. Reisman presented this agenda item. He stated that the Commission is preparing a report for the Legislative Budget Board (LBB). Mr. Reisman discussed the strategies and that he had asked the LBB to revise the strategies to better reflect what the Commission does. He discussed the breakdown of the budget regarding funding for disclosure filings, enforcement, legal guidance and opinions, central administration, and information resources. Mr. Reisman then discussed the exceptional items requests – electronic filing software system, staff retention, and exempt salary positions. Commissioner Untermeyer moved to include a request for \$50,000 for education of regulated community; second by Commissioner Akin. Motion passed by a vote of seven ayes. The request for \$50,000 to be included in the exceptional requests to the LBB was adopted.

Agenda Item 8: Report from the subcommittee of commissioners on the investigation and prosecution of persons or entities who fail to register with the Texas Ethics Commission as required by law.

Commissioner Mendoza presented this agenda item. She stated that at this time there were outstanding questions. Commissioner Mendoza also stated that the Commission should request information from other organizations and individuals on what they are doing. The subcommittee will reconvene once the Commission gets all the information. She requested that notes on this agenda item should be given to Commissioner Harrison since he was not present during this agenda item. Jack Gullahorn, President, Professional Advocacy Association of Texas, spoke before the Commission. He stated that his organization supports strong lobby registration reporting requirements. Mr. Gullahorn stated that the laws and rules should be clear and understandable. He then discussed some of the Sunset Advisory Commission recommendations regarding the lobby 5% rule, preparatory time, and goodwill communications. He suggested that those issues could be clarified by rulemaking. Mr. Gullahorn further discussed the current filing requirements and statutory exceptions.

Commissioner Harrison arrived.

Edward M. Shack, attorney, spoke before the Commission. He stated that the 5% rule was created in the fall of 1991 (pre-Commission), as they did not want everyone to need to register as a lobbyist. They wanted to encourage participation in legislative day, for example, without the need to register.

Agenda Item 9: Report from the subcommittee of commissioners on recommendations for statutory changes to the 83rd Legislature as required by section 571.073 of the Government Code.

This agenda item was tabled until the next Commission meeting. There was no objection.
